As Methanex's President and Chief Executive Officer, John Floren has been with Methanex since 2000 and brings more than 30 years of diverse international management experience in the chemicals industry.

Before assuming his current role as President and CEO, Mr. Floren held a variety of positions with Methanex, including Senior Vice-President, Global Marketing and Logistics. As the world's largest methanol producer and supplier, Methanex has continued to advance its long-term strategy and maintain its leadership position in the global methanol industry. By 2016, Methanex plans to grow its operating capacity by approximately three million tonnes through delivering on a number of value-adding projects.

In 2013, the company added one million tonnes of operating capacity through growth projects completed in New Zealand and Medicine Hat. In January, 2015, its one million tonne methanol facility in Geismar, Louisiana successfully produced first methanol. The company is also in the process of relocating a second methanol plant from Chile to Geismar, Louisiana. The second plant, Geismar 2, is on target for methanol production in late Q1 2016.

Methanex maintains a strong financial position and is well positioned to grow earnings and cash flows in the coming years.

Mr. Floren's previous experience includes the Chairman of the Methanol Institute, Director of the Formaldehyde Council and the PALS Autism School, as well as the Chair of the Standardbred Canada Audit and Finance Committee.

Mr. Floren earned his Bachelor of Arts in Economics from the University of Manitoba in 1987. He also attended Harvard Business School's Program for Management Development in 1998 as well as the International Executive Program at INSEAD in 2002. In 2012, he completed the Directors Education Program at the Institute of Corporate Directors. He is married and has two daughters. When he finds a spare moment, chances are you will find him playing golf, soccer or hockey.
