

Agave Fiber Reinforced

General

We purchase blue agave fiber from a processor based in Central Mexico. The fiber is a bi-product from the production of tequila. The agave plant (related to the aloe plant) is cultivated for the purpose of producing tequila; thus new “shoots” are replanted continually.

The plant is very fibrous. These fibers are separated and processed into lengths that are usable in our manufacturing process.
